SHADOW-AN-ATTORNEY PROGRAM 2006 LAW STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

The New Haven County Bar Association, in collaboration with Quinnipiac University School of Law, will offer a Shadow-an-Attorney program in March 2006. To participate, you will need a completed application form and an approved resume, as follows:

1. Obtain an application from the Career Services Office.
2. Post and upload an approved* resume to this event on www.QULawjobs.com.

* Approved resumes have been reviewed with Deborah Daddio, Director of Career Services, or Doretta Sweeney, Associate Director of Career Services.

New Haven County Bar Association will then:

- Match the student with an attorney based upon his/her practice area interests on or before February 28th.
 - E-mail the attorney's contact information to the student by February 28th. The student will be responsible for contacting the attorney by March 3rd and scheduling a mutually convenient date and time for the "shadowing."
 - Forward a copy of the law student's resume and contact information to the attorney.
3. Please be sure to send the attorney a thank you note within a week of the shadowing day.

This is neither a job search program nor does the attorney incur an obligation to hire the law student. This is simply a career day to allow a law student to see the inner workings of a law office and the daily activities of an attorney.

Remember, placement is subject to attorney availability.
